# #CreateYourope – "Making Europe Greener", the example of the Ruhr region

How do we preserve our liveable Europe? How can we shape a sustainable Europe together? And how can we point out the importance of the European Community to its citizens?



Young people from the Ruhr metropolitan region address these questions at the creative ideas-marathon #CreateYourope. The event will take place as a digital social makerthon as part of the Europe Week NRW from 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> May 2021. Together with experts from science and politics, the young people will develop project ideas for the Metropole region Ruhr and impulses for а green, sustainable and participatory Europe. #CreateYourope

invites about 120 students from the Ruhr region and 3 European cities to find innovative solutions for challenges in the fields of sustainability and climate change.

Within the framework of the thematic focus "Making Europe Greener" of the Europe Week, the pupils will be working on the following four challenges:

- 1. How can sustainable innovations help to fight the climate crisis?
- 2. How can we make mobility in the Ruhr metropolitan region become more sustainable?
- 3 Upcycle your life Does everything have to go straight into the bin?
- 4. Europe 2030 How do we want to live in Europe in the future? (European Challenge)

**#CreateYourope** is organised by the **Regionalverband Ruhr (RVR)**, Department for Education and Social Affairs in cooperation with the Department for European Affairs, in cooperation with the **European Science Engagement Association (EUSEA)** and **city2science**.













### Format and goals of #CreateYourope

**#CreateYourope** takes place as a social makerthon. Makerthons are an innovative approach for tackling complex societal challenges. The word is made up of the terms "maker" and "marathon". Makers are creative minds for whom the focus is on DIY and the joint search for solutions. While traditional "hackathons" focus on technical and digital solutions to problems, social makerthons promote diverse approaches to solutions, which may also be of a social and creative nature, for example. Social Makerthons are therefore ideal formats to engage young generations in democratic forms of engagement and thus promote social innovation and inclusion on a local as well as a European level. **#CreateYourope** empowers young people to actively shape the future of Europe. It promotes awareness of the role and rights of young people in regional innovation processes through participatory problem-solving approaches.



#### **Programme**

**#CreateYourope** will take place as a 3-days online event from 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> May 2021. In the course of a dynamic "innovation sprint", 4 teams built of young people will develop ideas and concrete prototypes for the 4 challenges mentioned above. They will be accompanied by scientists and political decision-makers who will provide them with input and feedback on the respective topic of the challenge and the developed solutions. Challenge No. 4 will be worked on in English and in an international team with European young people from 3 partner cities of the Metropole region Ruhr.
